



CREATING YOUNG HOUDINIS!

Is there a “Young Houdini” in your community? You’ll find out when professional magician Danny Orleans teaches his Ultimate Magic Club Workshop in your library, park district or community center.

Mr. Orleans is a graduate of Northwestern University’s School of Education and, for the last 25 years, has performed his educational and entertaining magic shows at schools, park districts, country clubs, and theaters — anywhere that families gather to interact and have fun.

THE MAGIC WORKSHOP

Mr. Orleans teaches so much more than magic tricks in his Workshop. When a child learns magic tricks they also learn the importance of:

- Working with other children during practice sessions
- Following instructions *exactly* in order to make the trick work.
- Improving small motor and eye-hand coordination
- Creating a “script” of words to accompany their performance.
- Caring for (and sometimes making) their own props.

DAILY OR WEEKLY CLASSES

Mr. Orleans has created a variety of curriculums to meet every class size and length. He can do a one-day workshop during a school holiday, or he can create a customized program for you depending upon your schedule. His recommendations are:

- Class length: 90 minutes for younger children.
Two hours for older children.
- 4–5 classes per week with a Student Performance on the final day.
- 12 children per class.

Danny Orleans has brought his Magic Workshop to The Schaumburg Public Library for 4 consecutive years. Here his younger students (2nd–4th grades) show off their Cup and Ball trick.





AGE APPROPRIATE TRICKS
